11 Ways to Use Weapons Screening Data from Evolv Insights® for Improved Fan and Guest Experience—and Better Security

Legacy Security Screening Fails at Fan and Patron Experience

Ingress security screening remains a significant pain point for most ticketing venues. Fans and patrons want touchless, frictionless experiences, and ticketing venues want to give that to them. At the same time, ticketing venues must ensure the safety and security of fans and patrons by instituting appropriate security measuring—which includes security screening.

However, legacy walkthrough and hand-wand metal detectors are a significant hurdle. They cannot scale to meet the volumes of fans and patrons who need to be screened. A large percentage of security alarms are false positives, prompting fans and patrons to pass through secondary security screening. Lengthy lines form in front of event entrances, which frustrate fans and patrons and

create additional security risks. At the same time, unable to get fans and patrons into the venue, organizations lose opportunities for additional revenue from concessions and different retail stores.

Security screening was already a significant problem before the COVID-19 pandemic. Studies conducted in the past year show that is an even more pressing issue for many organizations. For example, a study conducted by the National Center for Spectator Sports Safety and Security at the University of Southern Mississippi found that 65% of sports venues said COVID-19 restrictions caused increased tensions between patrons and staff.¹ One-third of them reported incidents between patrons waiting to enter the venue. Getting staff to manage the legacy metal detector technologies is also a problem: 95% of organizations surveyed experienced staffing shortages in the past two years.

11 Use Cases for Evolv Insights in Performing Arts Centers

The following are 11 use cases involving the use of Evolv Insights analytics for ticketing venues. While not every one of them may be applicable to your organization, many likely are relevant and will enable your organization to generate greater value from your Evolv Express systems.

- 1 Optimize Use of Security Staff.**
Determine ingress volume down to five-minute intervals at each entrance per event type and allocate security staff based on those flows. This enables security and operations teams to optimize staff for maximum efficiencies and efficacy.
- 2 Assign Risk Based on Event Type.**
Drill down into volume of weapons found per different event types (e.g., football, baseball, operatic performance, specific artists, concerts, etc.) and allocate security staff accordingly. Organizations can scale security and operations staff based on threat vectors to minimize risk.
- 3 Eliminate Wait Queues.**
Streamline fan, patron, and employee/worker ingress flows by identifying entrances with the highest and lowest volumes based on event type and entrance time to eliminate wait queues. Optimization of security staffing resources also empowers organizations to deliver better fan and patron entrance experiences by reallocating staff to non-security functions (e.g., ticketing and concessions, ride areas in a theme park, etc.).
- 4 Address Insider Threats.**
Employ security screening for fans and patrons as well as employees—security, guest services, ticketing, and concessions staff—to address potential insider threats. The need for employee security screening is heightened by the fact that temporary, volunteer, and subcontracted staff work at many sports stadiums.
- 5 Pinpoint Number of Fans and Patrons.**
Count total number of fans and patrons attending each event and generate corresponding reports for executive staff, marketing, sales, and operations. Counting fans and guests down to the level of their arrival times provides organizations with the ability to make strategic decisions concerning future event attendance, marketing activities, ticketing, concessions, staffing across various functions, and more.
- 6 Enhance Security Efficacy.**
Analyze security alerts and threats confirmed based on entrance, performance type, time of entry, day of the week, and time of the year. Organizations can leverage this information for decision-making related to security staffing, sensitivity settings on Evolv Express systems, and secondary screening processes.
- 7 Reduce and Streamline Secondary Screening.**
Review data on false positives, location of threat detection on the body of fans (e.g., shoulder, ankle, waist), and the sensitivity level when threats were identified to reduce the number of secondary screenings without impacting the efficacy of security.
- 8 Optimize Parking Logistics.**
Analyze fan and patron ingress at each entrance and use that information to adjust parking lot logistics, bus arrivals, and disembarkation locations to ensure no wait queues form in front of any entrance. This also enables organizations to optimize staffing while delivering optimal fan and patron experiences.
- 9 Track and Analyze Weapons Detection.**
Track the number and types of weapons found, the location where the weapon was found on the body of the fan, patron, or employee, the ingress point, the time of arrival, and the sensitivity setting at which the Express system was running when the weapon was detected. This detailed weapons detection information allows organizations to reallocate security staffing resources, adjust sensitivity settings on the Express system, and adjust processes and flows for secondary screening.

Identify Staff Who Need Additional Security Training.

Track which alerts are tagged and untagged by individual security staff to identify those requiring “refresher” training on security systems and processes. This enables organizations to ensure staff managing Evolv Express systems get optimal value in terms of both efficiencies as well as efficacy. This is especially important due to many sports stadiums utilizing temporary, volunteer, and part-time staff for operations, guest services, concessions, and security.

Increase Revenue from Concessions.

Get fans and patrons into venues faster so that they have more time to spend in concessions and at retail stores in the venue. Evolv Insights enables security and operations teams to pinpoint which entrances are used most often and to merchandise concessions in those areas accordingly. Optimizing fan and patron ingress using analytics from Evolv Insights also shortens the time in security screening while increasing the time spent in concessions.

We looked at the flow of traffic around the southeast gate, and we found that fans kept shifting to the left, which pushed most of the traffic through a couple of the Express systems while leaving almost no traffic going through the one on the far right. We took this information and concluded that we needed to reposition our ticket scanners so that all of the Express lanes at that gate get significant traffic.
